A new full-time consultant post has been created to support service delivery and teaching in the Oral Medicine department within the Dental Directorate.

The department provides, in particular, non-surgical management of oral ulceration, inflammatory and infective disorders, white and red patches, vesiculobullous lesions, pigmentation, salivary gland disorders and pain of the orofacial region.

The Dental Directorate is also part of the Kings College London Dental Institute, and all consultants are expected to take part in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching during their normal clinical work, in addition to providing leadership in audit programme, health and safety, clinical governance activities and active contribution to the management of clinical services and service development.
